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COMPANY PROFILE

TRK Corporation was founded in 1973 and taken public in July, 1982 (ticker: 1432). Shopping malls and sports & recreation are TRK's two main areas of business at present.

In addition to Taroko batting ranges, bowling alleys and a karting track, we have also invested in the American Village resort on Yangmingshan. TRK has been active in developing innovative niche projects as well. In 2020, we opened the retro American-style Roller186 skating rink, which has become an Instagram hotspot, and in 2021, Taiwan's first Japanese-style hot stone spa in Hsinchu, which was an instant hit.



2022 Q1~Q3 YOY 39.71 %




EBDA & EBITDA

TRK Digital Transformation Mobile Payment (APP-activated pitching machine)

A mobile payment system for our batting ranges was completed in 2021, allowing pitching machines to be activated through our APP.

This system allows us to better understand our customers spending habits and increase efficiency through analysis of the data produced, resulting in optimized service and a new consumer experience for our customers.

In the future, we will continue to expand our batting range facilities, create multiple uses for our APP, making it more flexible and easier to use, and further integrate the resources of our different business units to create a mobile payment ecosystem.

Shareholder Gifts Made Available Through APP

For the first time, shareholder gifts were made available through our APP, which was met with an enthusiastic response from our shareholders. In 2022, more than 80,000 shareholders used our APP to gain convenient access to their gifts.

Shareholders also received discount coupons through the APP, bringing additional crowds and revenue to Taroko sports and leisure venues, while at the same time giving back to shareholders and enhancing brand awareness.
